This list presents communities, forums, and associations offering reliable industry information, case studies, and expert insights for open source intelligence (OSINT) and cyber threat intelligence (CTI) professionals to leverage in their daily work. It is provided in alphabetical order and does not imply any preference.

### ANTI-PHISHING WORKING GROUP (APWG)

An international coalition for combating phishing and cybercrime through shared information, best practices, and collaboration among industries, governments, and law enforcement.

### <u>DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY</u> (DIA) OSINT PORTAL

While not a community in the traditional sense, the DIA OSINT Portal provides government users with access to OSINT resources, tools, and training.

## FEDERAL LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING CENTERS (FLETC)

FLETC offers OSINT training programs tailored to government, law enforcement, and intelligence professionals.

## FORUM OF INCIDENT RESPONSE TEAMS (FIRST)

An international organization bringing together a variety of security and incident response teams, including government, commercial, and academic sectors, to improve security cooperation and information sharing.

### INFORMATION SYSTEMS AUDIT AND CONTROL ASSOCIATION (ISACA)

An association focused on IT governance, offering resources and certifications for IT, audit, risk, cybersecurity, and governance professionals, including those interested in OSINT and CTI.

### INTEL TECHNIQUES FORUM

A community focused on OSINT techniques and tools, including discussions relevant to government intelligence professionals.

# INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT INTEL ANALYSTS (IALEIA)

While primarily focused on intelligence analysis, IALEIA provides a platform for sharing OSINT-related best practices and resources among government intelligence analysts.

### LAW ENFORCEMENT INTELLIGENCE UNIT (LEIU)

Primarily focused on law enforcement, LEIU provides valuable resources and networking opportunities for government intelligence professionals involved in OSINT.

# MESSAGING, MALWARE AND MOBILE ANTI-ABUSE WORKING GROUP (M3AAWG)

A forum dedicated to the fight against malware, messaging abuse, and other forms of online exploitation and cybercrime, promoting operational collaboration and information sharing.

#### **OPEN CSIRT FOUNDATION**

An organization aimed at supporting Computer Security Incident Response Teams (CSIRTs) and improving global cyber security cooperation and information sharing.

#### **OSINT CURIOUS**

A group dedicated to advancing OSINT skills and knowledge, with members from various sectors including government intelligence.

#### **OSINT DOJO**

This community provides resources, tutorials, and discussions specifically tailored to government OSINT practitioners.

#### **OSINT-FR**

A global community, gathering experts and learners willing to develop their knowledge on open-source intelligence techniques.

### **OSINT TECHNIQUES**

A site offering numerous free open-source resources for researching and analyzing information, most helpful to those in investigative roles, such as analysts and researchers.
